The Role

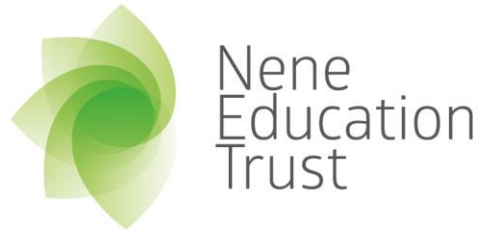
To ensure high quality education for all pupils across the Trust and improve the quality of learning and standards of achievement. And provide a secure, happy and caring environment for all children in the class.

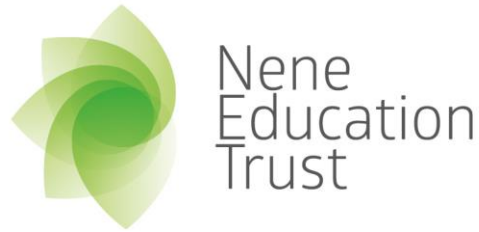
